





Metodologie

- The survey was conducted by INSCOP Research in partnership with Verifield, at the request of Capital magazine
- The data was collected between 20 - 24 of March 2020
- The research method: interview survey through questionnaire
- The data was collected using CATI (computer-assisted telephone interviewing). The sample that included 800 persons is representative for the non-institutionalized population of Romania, aged 18 and over.
- The maximum permissible error of the data is $\pm 3.5\%$, at a confidence level of 95%.

Perceived personal risk of infection


How high do you think is the risk of you personally getting infected with the coronavirus? (% of total sample)



The economic impact of the epidemic


Do you think that the Romanian economy will or will not be affected by the coronavirus epidemic? (% of total sample)
